Designation of the technical service

Decision

The Finnish Transport Safety Agency has decided to approve the DEKRA certification B.V. as a category A technical service defined in the Finnish Vehicles act 1090/2002 section 47, Directive 2007/46/EC Annex V and UNECE document ECE/TRANS/WP.29/1059 Annex 1 into the competence scope determined in the appendices with a national emblem TL-0010. The technical service shall use national emblem in all given documents.

Terms of validity

1. Technical service ensures that the operation of the approved competence area fulfils requirements of the standard EN ISO/IEC 17025.
2. Technical service maintains a register from completed inspections, measurements, tests, calculations and clarifications.
3. Technical service ensures that the functions constantly fulfill the requirements and terms set as the prerequisite of the decision.
4. Technical service operates according to the operational system, directions and clarifications presented during the evaluation of competency.
5. Technical service reports to Trafi without delay, and at least within 20 days, regarding changes made in its organization or operational preconditions which can affect its operation as a technical service or fulfilling the requirements set in this decision.
6. Technical service files its annual report to Trafi within two months after completion, or a separate clarification if the annual report does not include information concerning operation as a technical service during the business year.
7. Technical service Can use a qualified subcontractor to do inspections, measurements, tests and calculations with permission of the manufacturer or manufacturers laboratories or measurement/test equipment as the standard of the decision prerequisites. Technical service is responsible for the inspections, measurements, tests, calculations, evaluations and assessments made by the subcontractor. Technical service assures that the requirements of the standards are fulfilled.

8. Technical service assures a possibility for Trafi or body authorized by Trafi to perform inspections granted by Vehicles act and the regulations given by the Vehicles act itself. The inspections are done at applicant's expense.

9. Technical service ensures that Trafi or body authorized by Trafi has access to material regarding proof of independence, competence of personnel, system, equipment and requisites. This requirement also concerns inspections, measurements, tests, calculations and clarifications

10. Technical service reports on its participation in national or international co-operation or proves in some other way it is equal to the requirements of Vehicles act, section 36 §

11. Providing that there have been relevant deficiencies or neglect of regulations, or neglect of conformity has occurred during supervision or re-evaluation, the action to correct the identified deficiencies must take place within a month.

12. The technical service must report without delay from the end of functions

This decision is valid according to the accreditation until 1.3.2018 presuming there will be no changes in the accreditation or status of the technical service before that.

Withdrawal of the approval is enacted in the Finnish Vehicles act, section 50.
